Matters Arising from minutes of 17th October 2018

It was agreed that all matters from the last meeting have been resolved.

Duncan Richardson reported that he had looked at the accounts and had completed an audit of these. However, he was not in possession of all information and raised a question regarding £50 being short on the bonfire finance account. This was explained as being a cash payment on the night to the bouncy castle operator to attend the event. Mr Richardson suggested that is made clear in future. He also questioned a payment of £49.50 to Phil Farmer for a raffle prize for the Halloween function that he ran. This is again to be made clear in the accounts.

Precept 2019/2020

Mr Cammack presented to the council the proposed precept for 2019/2020.
